

"The New ASHRAE Standard 189.1-2011 for High Performance Green Buildings"

ASHRAE has developed a new standard for High Performance, Green Buildings (Standard 189.1-2011). The Standard provides the minimum requirements for a high-performance green building, and was developed with the intent to provide a balance of environmental factors involved with designing, building, and planning for the operation of buildings. This session provides a detailed look at the Standard, the background on its development and what is foreseen for its application and ultimate adoption.

Dr. Lawrence is a Senior Public Service Associate with the University of Georgia and has 30 years of professional experience in engineering and environmentally related fields. Before going back for his Ph.D. in Mechanical Engineering at Purdue, he spent approximately 20 of those years in industry and consulting. He is the past chair of ASHRAE Technical Committee 2.8, "Building Environmental Impact and Sustainability", and is a member of the committee which wrote the ASHRAE standard on high-performance green buildings (Standard 189.1). As an ASHRAE Distinguished Lecturer, he gives presentations and workshops on green building design at venues around the world. At the University of Georgia, Dr. Lawrence teaches courses in HVAC, Green Building Design, Residential Building Design, and Heat Transfer.



#### **New Changes to Members Council**

During the 2011 fall meeting in Atlanta, a motion was approved to remove the Director and Regional Chairs (DRCs) as members of Members Council and to have them sit on the Board of Directors only. The DRCs will be replaced by a new position from each region called the Region Members Council Representative. Pending approval by the membership for an ASHRAE Bylaws change, this will become effective July 1, 2013.
